The Hearing House holds a contract with the Northern Cochlear Implant Trust to provide paediatric cochlear implant services in the upper North Island of New Zealand. The Hearing House is a not-for-profit organisation that specialises in achieving spoken language outcomes for children with significant hearing loss using cochlear implants. The position is based at our Centre in Greenlane, Auckland, New Zealand.

This service provides cochlear implant audiological care for children in the paediatric programme including pre-implant assessment, NRT in theatre, switch-on, device programming, and post-implant evaluation. You will be part of a multi-disciplinary team including cochlear implant Audiologists, Auditory-Verbal Therapists, Preschool Teachers and a Family Counsellor. The ability to work well within a small and close team, as well as independently, is essential. Strong communication and interpersonal skills are a must.

We are looking for an audiologist preferably with paediatric and/or cochlear implant audiological experience who is interested in working with children and their families who have been referred for cochlear implantation. Cochlear implant training may be provided on the job and through Cochlear Pty.
